## 2019 Reserve Killer Cab

75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Syrah, 3% Petit Verdot

### Vintage:

2019 could be represented in a few words: low yield and great quality.

Slightly cooler than other years yet with the lower yield the fruit was concentrated with slightly lower sugars and higher acidity, which creates a wine that is truly designed to age!

### Winemaking:

Each varietal of this blend was picked on October 16th, 2019, with a 24-hour cold storage before a destemming and gentle crush. Each one was fermented separately in stainless steel for 14-22 days with twice a day pump-overs to extract tannin and body. Aged in premium American Oak for 30 months, unfinned and unfiltered before bottling.

### Aroma & Palate:

Aromas of strawberry, anise and plum lead into a palate of blackberry, spiced caramel, currant and a hint of black pepper. Acidity balances the powerful tannin perfectly and you are left with the lingering warmth of toasted vanilla.

### Pairings:

Tomahawk-steak, blue cheese or simply the darkest of chocolate.

### The Numbers:

15% Alcohol - 5.5 g/L TA - 3.58 pH - 1.2 g/L RS
